r. David Clark, the fourth of twelve children, was born in New Orleans, LA. His early childhood days were spent sharecropping in several Louisiana towns. During that time, Dr. Clark repeated the third grade because he spent more time during the school year farming than he did in the classroom. His family later relocated to Texas and eventually settled in Houston. Upon graduating high school, Dr. Clark enlisted in the U.S. Navy and worked as an electrician. During his service in the Navy, he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Electronics Engineering and retired after 20 years at the rank of Senior Chief.

Subsequent to his military experience, he worked for two years with the Raytheon Service Company as a Systems Engineer. After Raytheon, he went to work for the Naval Sea Systems Command as an Electrical Engineer and continued there until 2005. During this assignment, Dr. Clark managed the design and logistics of electrical systems and propulsion on ships. He also was selected for the Commander's Development Program, a preparatory program for senior managers. While in the program, in 1996, he earned a Master of Science degree in Systems Management. He also managed the Y2K certification for Ship Systems and managed propulsion systems controls for aircraft carriers. He retired from the Navy Department in 2005.

Dr. Clark furthered his religious preparation by earning a Master of Arts degree in Religious Studies from Howard School of Divinity in 1988 and a Doctor of Ministry in Christian Counseling in 2013 from Maple Springs Baptist Bible College and Seminary (MSBBCS). In 2000, he became an Assistant Professor at MSBBCS; and since 2014, he served as MSBBCS' Director of Planning and Assessment where he has interacted directly with the accrediting organization Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools. In January 2017, Dr. Clark was appointed President/ Chief Executive Officer of MSBBCS. During his tenure, Dr. Clark worked with the leadership at MSBBCS to promote the institution and establish relationships to increase its visibility and student enrollment.

Dr. David Clark currently serves on the Board of Trustees and Stewards at Hemingway Temple Church in Washington, DC. He is married to the former Mildred Trammell, and their union has spanned more than 53 years. They are blessed with two daughters, a son-in-law, and Dr. Clark's best friend and favorite granddaughter, Macy.


Since 1982, Dr. Henry Pinckney Davis, III has been preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ, having been licensed and ordained at the St. Paul Baptist Church of Atlantic Highlands, New Jersey, under the pastoral leadership of his father, Dr. Henry P. Davis, Jr. His preaching is relevant, challenging, and inspirational. In 2000, Dr. Davis was called to pastor the First Baptist Church of Highland Park in Landover, Maryland. He formerly pastored the Second Canaan Baptist Church in Harlem, New York (1993-2000) and the Community Baptist Church in Lakehurst, New Jersey (1988-1993).

Dr. Davis leads a "Bible Believing, Christ Centered & Spirit Led Congregation" with an active membership of over 3,000 Disciples who are engaged in Kingdom Building through more than 80 ministries. The church has five worship assemblies each week with three weekend worship services — Saturdays at 6:30 p.m.; Sundays at 7:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m., and two on Wednesdays, which are referred to as Wonderful Wednesdays With Jesus, at 12 Noon is The Power Hour and at 6:45 p.m., which is a time of corporate Prayer, Praise, Worship, and The Word. First Baptist Highland Park is a progressive and visionary church that offers a Christian school (Highland Park Christian Academy - Pre-K - 8th Grade) and numerous Bible study groups. The church also has a senior citizens center and offers ministries to reach out to the youth, young adults, couples, singles, prisoners, sick, bereaved and widowed. The church currently has a \$20 million plus worship center.

Dr. Davis, a native of Wichita Falls, Texas, studied at Oral Roberts University, (Tulsa, Oklahoma) later graduated from Norfolk State University, (Norfolk, Virginia) with a B.A. in English; Fairleigh Dickinson University (New Jersey) with a Master of Public Administration; New Brunswick Theological Seminary (New Jersey) with a Master of Divinity (M.DIV.); and United Theological Seminary (Dayton, Ohio) with a Doctor of Ministry (D.Min.). Dr. Davis has been the recipient of numerous awards and citations, including being inducted into the Martin Luther King Jr. Board of Preachers at Morehouse College of Atlanta, Georgia in 2007.
