# School Supplies & Backpacks

Helping ensure students succeed in school



The "Save A City" event numbers have doubled and tripled over the last five years, resulting in the need for more backpacks and school supplies for the children in the community and surrounding areas. It is a blessing for us to provide our future business owners, scientists, police officers, engineers, doctors, educators and the like, with the basic tools and resources they need to succeed in school.

The importance of distributing backpacks and school supplies to students at our annual "Save A City" event comes as no surprise. Based on the 2016-2020 census, Prince George's County's high school graduation rate was only 87.2%. It is apparent that this is a number that needs to be improved.

With the help of private and public sponsors, we distributed approximately 300 backpacks during the launch of our backpack initiative in 2018. However, since

the pandemic began two years ago, this number has increased to over 1200. This year, we plan to fill 1500 backpacks with essential school supplies. Moreover, we will continue to encourage and support our community to achieve higher graduation rates throughout the county.

### **Food Distribution**

Feeding families in need

Combating the current food disparities in our local area was one of the most significant components of the "Save A City" initiative - even more so during the pandemic, which shows how critical this support can be for struggling families. A growing number of low- to moderate-income families lack sufficient funds to keep food on the table due to the high cost of essential items. For this reason, we have

partnered with Celestial Manna, the Capital Area Food Bank, Stand Up & Deliver, and other public and private donors in the National Capital Region to ensure that families have access to fresh fruits and vegetables, beans, poultry, eggs, bread, and more. In addition, our pantry is also open to families every Saturday.

Our "Food Distribution Center" has served more than 40,000 families

from June 2018 through April 2022. Isn't it exciting to see all the positive things happening in our community?

Livery year, we aim to provide the community with a wide range of healthcare resources and services and assist families with finding ways to access quality health care. The health component of "Save A City" is becoming increasingly crucial for many residents living in Prince George's County, where 8.6% of the population is considered underserved and 13% have no or limited health insurance (the highest rate of people without insurance throughout MD's 24 Jurisdictions).\*

Access to free or reduced-cost healthcare coverage and services are available to anyone, documented or undocumented, insured or underinsured. Therefore, we have partnered with various healthcare organizations such as Kaiser Permanente, Luminis Health, Amerigroup, Maryland Physicians Care, and a host of other local and private healthcare professionals throughout the DMV to provide FREE services such as vision/ hearing/blood pressure screenings, Covid vaccinations and boosters, HIV information and testing, cancer awareness and education, healthy eating, fitness classes, and much more.\*\*

We invite healthcare organizations and licensed medical professionals

to join us in this effort by volunteering your time to create a bridge between socioeconomic divides and contribute to improving the quality of life in the community.
